I. CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order at 6:10 PM.

- II. OWNER'S FORUM:
 - Newspapers are stacking up outside of Unit 211. The owner of Unit 211 needs to be contacted and they need to call the Oregonian to stop delivery. Vasily will be told to pick them up and recycle them if there are more than 2 to 3 papers piled in front of Unit 211's door. Donica Patell needs to be called and make the Oregonian stop delivering to Unit 215.
 - The sign that Metro put on the gate needs to be removed.
 - Power washing the Courtyard Dave will recommend someone and get a proposal for the work to be done. The public sidewalks will be a separate bid.

VI. OTARD PROPOSAL: Stanley Townsend presented the proposal from Able Communications for the installation of digital off-air antennae for the local channels free to air. The cost of the installation is \$2,150 and would allow each resident to choose over the air, Comcast or DIRECTV. William Meyer made a motion to accept the proposal. Sara Burton seconded and the motion was carried out unanimously. Able will provide a cost information sheet based on the size of the antennae.
